Having thoroughly examined the full record, the Court concludes that leave was improvidently granted because defendant had previously filed a motion for relief from judgment, MCR 6.502, which was denied. Under the circumstances presented, and pursuant to MCR 6.502(G), we find that defendant was precluded from filing subsequent motions for relief from judgment, as there was no intervening change of law, or new "evidence." Leave was granted with respect to the orders on the subsequent motions; therefore, leave was improvidently granted. This appeal is hereby DISMISSED.
