The Court orders that the delayed application is DENIED for lack of merit in the grounds presented. Notably, Detroit Public Schools did not address the Commission's ruling that it waived its right to challenge the ruling by failing to file exceptions from the initial decision of the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). MCL 38.104(l) unambiguously bars Detroit Public Schools from challenging the ALJ's decision with the Commission or in this Court; thus, the Commission properly refused to change the ALJ's initial ruling.

The motion "to accept proposed statement of facts in lieu of ordering transcripts" is GRANTED.
