Donald S. Owens, Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The motion to strike appellant's brief is DENIED. The "factual allegations" of which appellee complains is appellant's legal argument, consisting of a presentation of its view of the facts and law, along with its inferences therefrom, aimed at persuading this Court to decide in its favor. That is not improper, and is essentially the definition of legal argument. Further, as appellee stated many times in its motion, it was able to counter appellant's argument in its own brief.
