The Court orders that the delayed application is DENIED without prejudice to defendant raising the issues in the trial court of whether he is unable to pay the court-ordered \$500 fine and \$500 cost and whether he can be ordered to serve a 90-day jail sentence due to his inability to pay the fine and cost. Defendant apparently has six months from his prison release after serving his felony-firearm sentence to pay the fine and cost, which pursuant to a plea agreement he agreed to pay in lieu of incarceration for his felon in possession of a firearm conviction. Defendant can raise the issues at the time the trial court enforces its directive. See *People v Jackson*, 483 Mich 271; 769 NW2d 630 (2008), and *People v Collins*, 239 Mich App 125, 135-136; 607 NW2d 760 (1999).
