The Court orders that the motion for peremptory reversal pursuant to MCR 7.211(C)(4) is GRANTED. The decision of the Kent Circuit Court, Family Division, terminating respondent-appellant's parental rights is PEREMPTORILY REVERSED, and the March 29, 2010, order of court effectuating its ruling is VACATED as premature. The Kent Circuit Court wrongly terminated the parental rights of respondent-appellant where respondent-appellant was deprived both of the right to counsel and of meaningful participation in most of the child protection proceedings below. In re Mason, 486 Mich 142; 782 NW2d 747 (2010); In the Matter of D M Kleyla Minor, ___ Mich App ___; ___ NW2d ___ (2010). These proceedings are REMANDED to the Kent Circuit Court for reinstatement of the child protection proceedings with regard to respondent-appellant, for the appointment of counsel and for the provision of appropriate services. This order has immediate effect. MCR 7.215(F)(2). This Court does not retain jurisdiction.
