The motion for immediate consideration is DENIED.

We particularly note that the examples of an "interested person" provided by MCL 700.1105(c) are plainly non-exhaustive because that statutory provision provides that an "interested person" "includes, but is not limited to" the examples it enumerates. Further, it appears at least arguable that appellant may be a "claimant" within the meaning of MCR 5.125(C)(11). This order is without prejudice to appellee advancing any argument regarding this Court's jurisdiction that she considers appropriate before the case call panel.
