Christopher M. Murray, Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The motion for an extension of time to file appellant's brief and for guidance is GRANTED TO THE EXTENT that the time for filing appellant's brief is extended until 21 days after entry of the trial court's order deciding the pending motion for a new trial or until 21 days after the transcript of the hearing on the motion for new trial is filed with the trial court clerk, whichever is later.

The trial court shall hear and decide the pending motion within 56 days after the Clerk's certification of this order and shall cause a transcript of any hearing on the motion to be prepared and filed within 21 days after completion of the proceedings.
