The Court orders that the motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

The motion for stay pending appeal is GRANTED in part, and paragraphs 3, 4, and 5 of the Court of Claims' March 4, 2011 order are STAYED. The provisions of the preliminary injunction requiring the 3% contribution to be placed into a separate interest bearing account shall remain in effect, and the contributions are not to be disbursed until further order of this Court.

On its own motion, the Court orders that the appeal be EXPEDITED. The appellants' brief is due no later than 35 days from the filing of the transcript. The appellees' brief is due no later than 21 days after the service of the appellants' brief. No extensions of time will be allowed for filing of the briefs except by order of the Court.

The Clerk of this Court is directed to place this case on the next available case call after the expiration of the time to file appellees' brief.

M. J. Kelly, J., would deny the motion for stay.
