

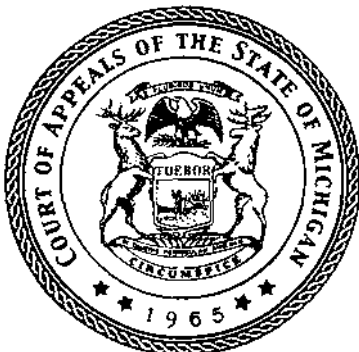
IN THE MICHIGAN COURT OF APPEALS

Re: **Michael Dwayne Peoples v Department of Corrections**

David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.201(B)(3), orders:

The original complaint for habeas corpus is DISMISSED for failure to pursue the case in conformity with the rules. MCR 7.201(B)(3) and 7.216(A)(10). The Clerk of this Court provided notice regarding the nature of the defects in this filing, and the defects were not corrected in a timely manner by providing this Court with the entry fee of \$375 or five copies of a motion to waive fees and a copy of plaintiff's prisoner account statement for the prior 12 months; two more copies of the petition/complaint for habeas corpus, five copies of a supporting brief for the complaint for habeas corpus conforming to MCR 7.212(C) to the extent possible; and proof of service of the petition/complaint and requested supporting brief on defendant. Dismissal is without prejudice to whatever other relief may be available consistent with the Court Rules.
