William B. Murphy, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the April 18, 2011, order appealed from is not a final order as defined in MCR 7.202(6). MCR 7.203(A)(1). The postjudgment order regarding child support cannot be considered an order affecting the custody of a minor under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(iii). At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the April 18, 2011, order only by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(F).

The motion to waive fees is GRANTED for this appeal only.
