The original complaint for superintending control is DISMISSED for failure to pursue the case in conformity with the rules. MCR 7.201(B)(3) and 7.216(A)(10). The Clerk of this Court provided notice regarding the nature of the defects in this filing, and the defects were not corrected in a timely manner by providing this Court with a current copy of plaintiff's prisoner account statement for the last 12 months, four more copies of the original complaint for superintending control, and proof of service of that original complaint on defendant and any other party involved in the case giving rise to the original complaint. Dismissal is without prejudice to whatever other relief may be available consistent with the Court Rules.

The motion to waive fees is also DISMISSED as moot.
