The Court orders that the motion to seal is GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART. Pursuant to MCR 7.211(C)(9)(b), "Materials that are subject to a protective order entered under MCR 2.302(C) may be submitted for inclusion in the Court of Appeals file in sealed form if they are accompanied by a copy of the protective order." To the extent appellants' motion to seal extends to such materials, the motion is GRANTED. The parties may submit all such materials in sealed form.

Appellants also request that this Court seal their "application for leave to appeal, including all attached exhibits, and all subsequent filings pertaining to this case in accordance with the terms of the protective order." The broad request to seal seems to extend to *all* filings with this Court. Clearly, not all pleadings and documents the parties will file fall within the protective order. For example, appellants indicate that only a portion of their exhibits are subject to the protective order, yet they request suppression of their entire application and all exhibits. Appellants have not demonstrated that good cause for sealing this Court's records in whole exists and that "there is no less restrictive means to adequately and effectively protect the specific interest asserted." MCR 8.119(F)(1). To the extent appellants' motion to seal extends to materials not covered by the protective order, appellants' motion to seal is DENIED.

The Clerk shall disclose or provide copies of any order or opinion entered in this appeal, MCR 8.119(F)(5); MCR 7.211(C)(9)(c), but sealed pleadings or other contents of the file shall not be disclosed or made available for public viewing.

The Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this order to the Clerk of the Supreme Court and to the State Court Administrative Office. MCR 8.119(F)(7); MCR 7.211(C)(9)(c)
