The Court orders that appellant's motion captioned as a "motion for a Ginther hearing and motion for extension of time to file brief on appeal" is recognized as a motion to remand. The motion to remand is DENIED for failure to meet the requirements of MCR 7.211(C)(1)(a) because it is not supported by an affidavit or offer of proof as to the contents of the video underlying the motion. Appellant's conclusory assertions that the video would have bolstered her testimony and contradicted the testimony of other witnesses do not constitute such an offer of proof.
