The Court orders that plaintiff's motion to compel defendant to comply with MCR 7.210(B)(1) by ordering the transcripts of all trial court proceedings and to extend the time within which plaintiff's brief is due is GRANTED.

Pursuant to MCR 7.210(B)(1), defendant is generally responsible for securing the filing of the full transcript of testimony and other proceedings in the trial court. Defendant did not move in the trial court for an order to include less than the full transcript in the record on appeal, as permitted by MCR 7.210(B)(1)(c). The parties did not stipulate that defendant may secure some portion less than the full transcript under MCR 7.210(B)(1)(d). For that reason, defendant is ORDERED TO REQUEST PREPARATION OF ALL TRANSCRIPTS of testimony and other proceedings in the trial court or tribunal.

Plaintiff's brief is due 35 days after the transcript is filed with the trial court.
