The Court orders that the motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

The motion for reconsideration is DENIED. In order for a law student to appear in court on behalf of an indigent defendant, "the indigent person that will be assisted by the student must consent in writing to the representation." MCR 8.120(D)(1). Because this Court has not received written consent from appellant Louis Wayne Ransom, law student Jory Hoffman will not be permitted to represent appellant at oral argument. MCR 8.120(D)(3).

Fitzgerald, J. would grant the motion to permit law student to conduct oral argument.
