The Court orders that the motion to remand is DENIED for failure to persuade the Court of the necessity of a remand at this time. We note that trial counsel's performance for purposes of an ineffective assistance of counsel claim is assessed under an objective standard of reasonableness. *People v Lockett*, 295 Mich App 165, 187; 814 NW2d 295 (2012). Thus, we conclude that there is no need for a remand merely to develop a record of trial counsel's subjective reasons for his relevant actions or omissions.
