The Court orders that the motion to remand is DENIED for failure to persuade the Court of the necessity of a remand at this time. We conclude that there is no sound basis for a remand merely to determine trial counsel's subjective reasons for failing to raise certain objections or issues because trial counsel's performance for purposes of an ineffective assistance of counsel claim is assessed under an objective standard of reasonableness. *People v Lockett*, 295 Mich App 165, 187; 814 NW2d 295 (2012).
