Donald S. Owens, Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The prosecutor's confession of error is accepted and the case is remanded for resentencing, the trial court having erred by failing to impose consecutive sentences as required by MCL 768.7a(2), and the trial court having erred by amending the judgment of sentence, without conducting a resentencing hearing, to order that the sentences imposed are to run consecutive to the sentence for which defendant was on parole when he committed the current crimes. *People v Turner*, 459 Mich 928; 589 NW2d 288 (1998); *People v Burton*, 459 Mich 876; 585 NW2d 299 (1997); *People v Nimeth*, 236 Mich App 616, 627-628, 601 NW2d 393 (1999); *People v Mapp*, 224 Mich App 432; 569 NW2d 523 (1997); *People v Thomas*, 223 Mich App 9; 566 NW2d 13 (1997). As resentencing is required, defendant's remaining claims of error regarding the scoring of offense variables 9, 13, and 14 need not be addressed on appeal.
