Elizabeth L. Gleicher, Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The motion to extend the time to file appellant's brief until after additional transcripts are filed is GRANTED TO THE EXTENT that the 21-day period to file appellant's brief under MCR 7.217(A) is EXTENDED until 35 days after the transcripts of proceedings held on February 2, 2009, March 27, 2009, May 26, 2011, August 4, 2011, August 19, 2011, August 22, 2011, and August 24, 2011, are filed with the trial court clerk. Appellant's brief shall be considered untimely when it is filed. The Clerk of the Court shall place this case on the involuntary dismissal docket without further notice to the parties if the appellant's brief is not filed in accordance with this order. Defendant-appellant's counsel shall secure the filing of the trial court's orders and the court reporters' certificates acknowledging receipt of the transcript orders within 21 days after the Clerk's certification of this order.
