## ORDER

## Re: David Schied v Charter Township of Redford Docket No. 308715 L.C. No. 11-014259-AW

Elizabeth L. Gleicher, Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The motion to waive fees is DENIED because appellant has failed to provide sufficient information regarding his assets to determine if he is unable to pay fees because of indigency and has not indicated that he is receiving public assistance on the basis of indigency. See MCR 2.002(D). MCL 780.758 concerns rights of alleged victims in criminal proceedings and does not entitle a plaintiff in a civil action to decline to provide critical information about his assets in connection with a motion to waive fees. Similarly, MCL 775.20 is inapplicable to this action.

Appellant shall pay to the Clerk of the Court, within 21 days of the certification of this order, the entry fee of \$375. Failure to comply with this order will result in the dismissal of the appeal.
