The Court orders that the motion to dismiss this appeal as moot pursuant to MCR 7.211(C)(2)(c) is GRANTED. In light of defendant's conviction by his plea under a plea agreement subsequent to this Court's order granting the application for leave to appeal, this appeal has been rendered moot because a decision by this Court as to whether the district court erred in allowing an involuntary intoxication defense can have no practical legal effect in this case. *People v Richmond*, 486 Mich 29, 34; 782 NW2d 187 (2010). Further, appellant cannot rely on the exception to allow for review of a moot issue that is likely to recur yet may evade judicial review where its own conduct in entering into a plea agreement with appellee has rendered this appeal moot. *Id.*, 39.
