## ORDER

The Court orders that appellants' motion to expedite the appeal is GRANTED. The time for taking further steps in this appeal is as follows:

(1) Appellants shall file their brief on appeal within seven days of the date of this order. This brief shall be personally served on appellee's counsel;

(2) Within seven days after being served with appellants' brief on appeal, appellee shall file appellee's brief which shall be personally served on appellants' counsel; and

(3) Appellants shall file any reply brief to appellee's brief on appeal within seven days after being served with appellee's brief on appeal and shall personally serve any reply brief on appellee's counsel.

The Court further orders that appellants' motion for stay pending appeal is GRANTED. Thus, defendant City of Flint Emergency Manager Michael K. Brown may exercise the powers provided by the Local Government and School District Fiscal Accountability Act, MCL 141.1501 et seq, during the pendency of this appeal. On its own motion, the Court waives the requirements of MCR 7.209(A).

The motion for immediate consideration of appellee's motion to strike is GRANTED. The motion to strike is DENIED.

This panel of the Court retains jurisdiction of the appeal.

Pursuant to MCR 7.215(F)(2), this order shall be given immediate effect.
