Pursuant to MCR 7.205(D)(2), the Court orders that the March 31, 2012 order is REVERSED to the extent it determines that appellant's claim under 42 USC § 1983 is barred by the statute of limitations. The statute of limitations for a § 1983 claim brought in a Michigan court is three years. Wolfe v Perry, 412 F 3d 707 (CA 6, 2005); MCL 600.5801(10). The evidence indicates that, at the earliest, plaintiff's claim accrued in September 2008, and he filed his claim in August 2010, well within the three-year limitations period. We REMAND this matter for a determination of plaintiff's § 1983 claim on the merits

The application for leave to appeal is otherwise DENIED for lack of merit in the grounds presented.

This Court retains no further jurisdiction.
