William B. Murphy, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is **DISMISSED** for lack of jurisdiction because the order of the circuit court on appeal from the district court is not appealable as a matter of right. MCR 7.203(A)(1)(a). An appeal from an order of the circuit court on appeal from another court must come by application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205. MCR 7.203(B)(2).

The motion to waive fees is **GRANTED** for this case only.

The motion to assign counsel, stay proceedings, and for immediate consideration is denied as moot.
