## ORDER

Re: **Wells Fargo Bank NA v Catherine Lawrence**

David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the April 24, 2012 order of the circuit court on appeal from the district court is not appealable as a matter of right. MCR 7.203(A)(1)(a). An appeal from an order of the circuit court on appeal from another court must come by application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205. MCR 7.203(B)(2). Accordingly, at this time, appellant may seek to appeal the April 24, 2012 order only by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(F).

The motion to waive fees is GRANTED for this case only.
