Pursuant to MCR 7.205(D)(2), in lieu of granting the delayed application for leave to appeal, the Court REMANDS this matter to the Livingston Circuit Court for the administrative task of correcting the presentence investigation report. In the last paragraph of the Evaluation and Plan section of the PSIR, which is found on page 2 of the report, the PSIR incorrectly reflects that the sentencing guidelines range was 7 to 46 months. The sentencing court shall amend the PSIR to reflect that the guidelines range was 5 to 46 months and shall transmit to the Department of Corrections a copy of the corrected PSIR. In all other regards, the delayed application for leave to appeal is DENIED. This order has immediate effect. We do not retain jurisdiction.
