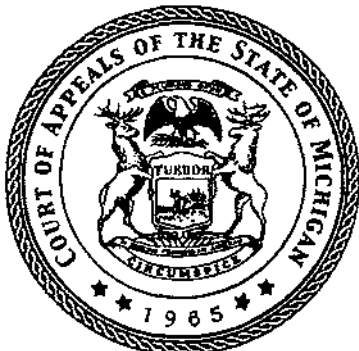

William B. Murphy, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the May 18, 2012 order does not appear to be a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). That order appears to merely deny a motion to change the domicile of the parties' minor child and not to be an order affecting custody so as to be a final order under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(iii). Notably, the Clerk's Office of this Court sent a request to appellant to provide a copy of the judgment of divorce and of the motion to change domicile in this case, but appellant has failed to provide those items as requested. This has precluded practical consideration of whether those items might indicate that this appeal affects the custody of a minor. At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the May 18, 2012 order by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(F).
