David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The original complaint for mandamus is **DISMISSED IN PART** as to defendant Manistee County Clerk for lack of jurisdiction because she is not a state officer. MCR 3.305(A)(1).

As to defendant Manistee Circuit Court, in lieu of dismissing the original complaint for mandamus for lack of jurisdiction as to that defendant, the original complaint for mandamus is treated as an original complaint for superintending control as to defendant Manistee Circuit Court. MCR 3.302(C). Further, to proceed with this case against defendant Manistee Circuit Court, plaintiff shall provide to the Clerk's Office of this Court five copies of a supporting brief (one signed) conforming to MCR 7.212(C) to the extent possible and proof of service of that brief on defendant Manistee Circuit Court, MCR 7.206(D)(1)(b)-(c), within 21 days of the date of this order. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in dismissal of this case.


Consistent with MCR 3.302(F)(1), the Clerk's Office of this Court is directed to change the title of this action to *In re Williams* upon entry of this order.
