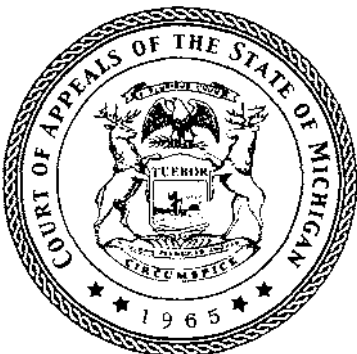

David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.201(B)(3), orders:

The original complaint for mandamus is DISMISSED for failure to pursue the case in conformity with the rules. MCR 7.201(B)(3) and 7.216(A)(10). The Clerk of this Court provided notice regarding the nature of the defects in this filing, and the defects were not corrected in a timely manner by providing this Court with the entry fee of \$375 or five copies of a motion to waive fees and a copy of plaintiff's prisoner account statement for the prior 12 months; three more copies of the complaint for mandamus; five copies of a supporting brief; and proof of service of the supporting brief on defendant. Dismissal is without prejudice to whatever other relief may be available consistent with the Court Rules.
