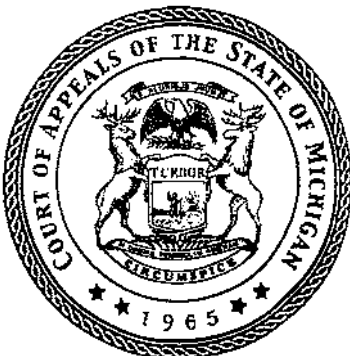

David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is **DISMISSED** for lack of jurisdiction because the December 12, 2011 judgment of sentence, which was based upon a plea of guilty or no contest to a crime committed after December 27, 1994, is not appealable as a matter of right. MCR 7.203(A)(1)(b). The appeal must come by application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205.

The Court would note that leave to appeal may be granted if a party's claim of appeal is dismissed for lack of jurisdiction after the 6-month limitation period has expired, and the party files a late application for leave to appeal from the same lower court judgment. A party filing a late application in reliance on this provision must note the dismissal of the prior claim of appeal in the statement of facts explaining the delay. MCR 7.205(F)(5).
