

William B. Murphy, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because it was not timely filed. MCR 7.204(A). The claim of appeal was not filed within 21 days after entry of the final order appealed from, the default judgment entered on March 19, 2012, or within 21 days after entry of the order denying defendants' motion to set aside the default judgment on May 24, 2012. MCR 7.204(A)(1); Allied Electric Supply Co, Inc, v Tenaglia, 461 Mich 285; 602 NW2d 572 (1999). The motion for reconsideration of the order denying defendants' motion to set aside the default judgment did not extend the time for filing the claim of appeal under MCR 7.204(A)(1)(b). Allied Electric, supra. At this time, defendants-appellants may seek to appeal only by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(F).
