The Court orders that the motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

The motion for leave to file an amicus curiae brief is GRANTED.

In lieu of granting the application for leave to appeal, pursuant to MCR 7.205(D)(2), the Court orders that the portion of the September 12, 2012 order that declared sections 4.1 and 4.3 of the Financial Stability Agreement void is REVERSED. The circuit court lacked jurisdiction to grant plaintiff relief where plaintiff failed to establish standing necessary to bring an action for declaratory judgment. MCR 2.605(A)(1); *Lansing Schools Ed Ass'n v Lansing Bd of Ed (On Remand)*, 293 Mich App 506, 515; 801 NW2d 95 (2010).

We do not retain jurisdiction.
