William B. Murphy, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the October 24, 2012 order setting aside a default and default judgment is not a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). That order is not a final order under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) because it does not dispose of appellant's claim against appellee, but rather sets aside the earlier disposition of the claim against appellee and thereby leaves the claim pending resolution in the circuit court. At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the October 24, 2012 order by filing an application or delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205.
