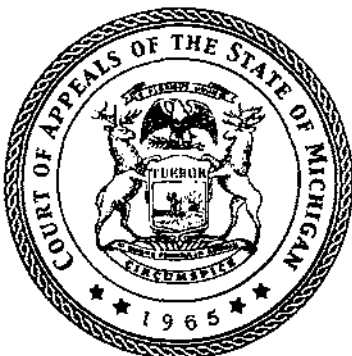

William B. Murphy, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The application for leave to appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the order appealed is not a final order of the MCAC where the order did not dispose of “all the claims” of the parties. MCR 7.202(6)(a)(1). This Court has jurisdiction only to consider appeals from final decisions or final orders of the MCAC and an order of the MCAC that remands the matter to the magistrate is not a final order, even where the MCAC does not retain jurisdiction. MCL 418.861a(14); *Smith v Eaton Corp Torque Controls*, 493 Mich 942; 826 NW2d 720 (2013).
