Defendant-appellant's motion to compel production of exhibits is GRANTED and this matter is REMANDED to the trial court to settle the record to ensure inclusion of the relevant photographic exhibit(s) requested by this Court. Within 14 days of the Clerk's certification of this order, defendant shall file an appropriate motion to initiate the remand proceedings.
