Elizabeth L. Gleicher, Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The motion to file a pro se supplemental brief and pro se motion to remand is DENIED for failure to establish good cause for the failure to file the brief and motion within the 84-day period provided under Administrative Order 2004-6, Standard 4. The pro se brief and motion to remand that were received with the motion are returned to appointed counsel with this order.

The motion to file another supplemental brief on behalf of defendant-appellant is also DENIED because the principal and supplemental briefs that have already been filed, taken together, exceed the 50 page limit under MCR 7.212(B). The denial is without prejudice to a motion to either file a supplemental brief to substitute for the supplemental brief that has been filed or file a single appellant's brief to substitute for both the principal and supplemental briefs that have been filed. The appeal is HELD IN ABEYANCE for 35 days after the Clerk's certification of this order to afford appointed counsel time to either file a motion that identifies the issues to be raised in a substitute brief or file written notice with the Clerk of this Court that defendant-appellant will proceed with the briefs as filed.
