The motions for immediate consideration are GRANTED.

The motion to stay proceedings pending appeal is DENIED.

Pursuant to MCR 7.205(D)(2), in lieu of granting the application for leave to appeal, the Court PEREMPTORILY REVERSES the decision of the trial court to include in the April 20, 2012 qualified protective order the provision directing defendants to give plaintiffs notice of and an opportunity to attend ex parte interviews by defense counsel with the treating physicians of plaintiff Glenda Dilworth-Stricklin, and directs that ¶ g be STRICKEN from the order. The trial court abused its discretion when it imposed these conditions in the absence of identified facts specific to this case showing that justice required the conditions. Szpak v Inyang, 290 Mich App 711; 803 NW2d 904 (2010). This order has immediate effect. MCR 7.215(F)(2). We do not retain jurisdiction.
