The Court orders that appellee's motion for oral argument is GRANTED. We recognize that appellee is incorrect in asserting that his brief on appeal was timely filed. Rather, appellee's brief on appeal was untimely because it was not filed within 21 days after service of appellant's brief on appeal in this criminal interlocutory appeal. MCL 7.212(A)(2)(a)(i). Further, appellee failed to note his request for oral argument on the title page of his brief on appeal. MCR 7.212(C)(1); MCR 7.212(D)(1). Nevertheless, we believe the interests of justice are best served by allowing appellee to present oral argument.
