The Court orders that the application for leave to appeal is GRANTED.

This motion for appointment of counsel is granted and this cause is REMANDED to the trial court for a determination whether to appoint appellate counsel for the defendant-appellant. Matters pertaining to the appointment of an attorney are decided in the trial court. MCR 7.208(G). The trial court shall determine whether to appoint counsel for defendant-appellant within 14 days of the Clerk's certification of this order. The trial court shall send a copy of the order deciding this issue and naming appointed counsel, if any, to the Clerk of this Court within 7 days of the decision.

Defendant-appellant's brief is due 56 days after entry of the order granting or denying the appointment of counsel or the transcript is filed, whichever is later, MCR 7.212(A)(1)(a)(iii), and plaintiff-appellee's brief is due 35 days after service of defendant-appellant's brief. MCR 7.212(A)(2)(a)(ii). The time for taking further steps in this appeal runs from the date of the Clerk's certification of this order. MCR 7.205(D)(3).

The motion to waive fees is GRANTED and fees are WAIVED for this case only.

This Court retains jurisdiction.
