The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the October 23, 2012 order is not a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(b); MCR 7.203(A).

The motion to add and amend appeal as of right by leave is DENIED because there is no need to grant such exceptional relief where defendant has ample time to file a delayed application for leave to appeal the October 23, 2012 order within the six-month time limit of MCR 7.205(F).

The motions for immediate consideration, for stay, and for appeal bond are DENIED as moot.

The motion to waive fees is GRANTED for this case only.
