The Court orders that the delayed application for leave to appeal is DENIED for lack of merit in the grounds presented. Defendant's sentence was proportional because it was within the guidelines and, consistent with the Cobb's agreement, concurrent to another offense to which defendant had already been sentenced to serve a minimum of 3 years and a maximum of 15 in the custody of the Michigan Department of Corrections. Moreover, defense counsel was not ineffective, and no plain error occurred, when defense counsel did not object to the trial court's order that, consistent with *People v Jackson*, 483 Mich 271; 769 NW2d 630 (2009), the Michigan Department of Corrections will make a determination of defendant's ability to pay costs and attorney fees at such time that collection efforts begin.

The Court further orders that the motion for remand is DENIED.
