The Court orders that the motion for the Court to pay for transcripts is DENIED because, as indicated in this Court's May 2, 2013 order, such relief should be requested by a motion in the trial court.

The motion for transcripts unavailable is DENIED because MCR 7.210(B)(1)(a) makes appellant responsible for securing the filing of the transcript.

The motion for extension of time to file statement of facts is DENIED as moot in light of the denial of the motion for transcripts unavailable.

The motion to remand is DENIED because it is grossly untimely where, rather than being filed within the time provided for filing appellant's brief on appeal as required by MCR 7.211(C)(1)(a), it was not filed until after briefing of this appeal was completed.


Within 21 days of the date of the Clerk's certification of this order, appellant shall either order the transcript of the February 26, 2013, summary disposition hearing and secure the filing of a stenographer's certificate acknowledging that the transcript has been ordered and that payment for the transcript has been made or secured, MCR 7.210(B)(3)(a), or file a motion in the trial court for preparation of that transcript at public expense and submit a copy of that motion to this Court. If appellant files a motion in the trial court for preparation of the transcript at public expense he shall submit a copy of the trial court's order deciding that motion to this Court within seven days after entry of such an order. The court reporter is directed to prepare the transcript of the February 26, 2013, hearing within 42 days after it is ordered. The Clerk's Office shall submit this case for involuntary dismissal under MCR 7.217(C) if appellant fails to comply with this order.
