The Court orders that the motion for peremptory reversal pursuant to MCR 7.211(C)(4) is DENIED. On its own motion and pursuant to MCR 7.216(A)(5), the Court orders that this matter is REMANDED to the trial court so that appellant may file, within 14 days, a motion for relief from judgment or order pursuant to MCL 722.1304(6) and MCL 2.612(C).

Appellant is to file with this Court a copy of any motion and any supporting brief filed in the trial court within 14 days of the Clerk's certification of this order. The trial court shall hear and decide this matter within 56 days of the Clerk's certification of this order. Appellant must also file with the Clerk of this Court copies of all orders entered on remand within 14 days after entry.

The trial court shall make findings of fact and a determination on the record. Appellant shall cause a transcript of any hearing on remand to be prepared and filed within 21 days after completion of the proceedings. This Court retains jurisdiction in this case, and the time for proceeding with the appeal in this Court begins upon issuance of an order in the trial court that finally disposes of the remand proceedings. If the appellant fails to file remand pleadings in the trial court within the 14-day period, the time for proceeding with the appeal in this Court begins 14 days from the date of certification of this order.
