David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.201(B)(3), orders:

The delayed application for leave to appeal is DISMISSED for failure to pursue the case in conformity with the rules. MCR 7.201(B)(3) and 7.216(A)(10). The Clerk of this Court provided notice regarding the nature of the defects in this filing, and the defects were not corrected in a timely manner by providing this Court with five copies of a brief conforming to MCR 7.212(C); five copies of the April 10, 2013, circuit court order being appealed; a copy of the registers of actions from the circuit court and the district court; proofs of service that the documents filed on June 11 and 12, 2013, were served on opposing counsel; and a proof of service of service on opposing counsel of the documents requested by this Court in the notice of defects. Dismissal is without prejudice to whatever other relief may be available consistent with the Court Rules.

The motion to waive fees is GRANTED for this case only.
