
David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

On the Court's own motion, the original complaint for mandamus is DISMISSED because plaintiff, a prisoner under the jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections, filed the subject original complaint even though he owes an outstanding balance to this Court in *Robert Sango v St Louis Correctional Facility Warden*, Docket No. 316006. A prisoner who is under the Department's jurisdiction cannot file another civil appeal or original action until the prisoner pays the outstanding balance owed in an earlier civil appeal or original action filed while under the Department's jurisdiction. MCL 600.2963(8).

The motion to waive fees is also DISMISSED as moot.


The motion to waive initial partial filing fees is DENIED. Under MCL 600.2963(8) plaintiff may not proceed with this case without paying the outstanding fee he owes this Court in Docket No. 316006. *Keenan v Dep't of Corrections*, 466 Mich 204, 204-205; 644 NW2d 756 (2002).
