Upon receipt of notice of the bankruptcy filing of defendant-appellant City of Detroit and notice of the July 25, 2013, order of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Michigan that, pursuant to 11 USC 105(a), extended the bankruptcy stay under 11 USC 362 and 11 USC 922 to include proceedings against certain State entities and non-officer employees, agents, and representatives of the City of Detroit, the Court concludes that it lacks the authority to continue its review of this case and orders that the appeal is CLOSED without prejudice.
