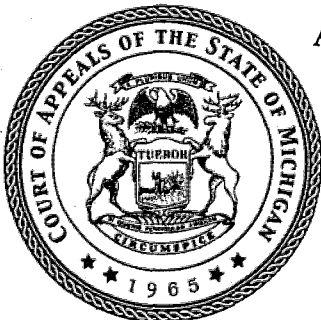

David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

Initially, although the claim of appeal states that appellant is claiming an appeal from an October 23, 2013 order, it must be recognized that the order appealed from is the October 7, 2013 order which appellant provides a copy of with the claim of appeal, particularly as there is no entry for October 23, 2013 in the copy of the register of actions provided. The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the October 7, 2013 order is not a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). That order is not a final order under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) because it does not dispose of any claim in this case but rather merely denies appellant's motion to amend the judgment of divorce and provides for further proceedings regarding the disputed pension-related matter without disposing of that matter. At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the October 7, 2013 order by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(F).
