The Court orders that the motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

The motion to waive the transcript requirement of MCR 7.205 is GRANTED.

In lieu of granting the application, the Court orders, pursuant to MCR 7.205(D)(2), that the November 6, 2013, order of the Wayne Circuit Court on appeal of a decision from the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Bureau of Health Care Services, Board of Pharmacy Disciplinary Subcommittee hereby is REVERSED. Pursuant to statute, jurisdiction for an appeal of a final decision of a disciplinary subcommittee rests only in this Court, MCL 333.16237(6), and the circuit court lacked subject matter jurisdiction over the appeal. The case is REMANDED to the circuit court for entry of an order dismissing the appeal.
