By order dated October 24, 2013, this Court remanded these consolidated appeals to the

trial court for supplemental findings regarding the child's best interests, including the issue of relative placement, and to address the compliance with the Indian Child Welfare Act (ICWA), 25 USC 1901 et seq. By written order, the trial court rendered additional factual findings, determining that termination of parental rights was in the best interests of the child and the ICWA requirements were satisfied. In light of the additional factual findings, we cannot conclude that the trial court clearly erred in holding that termination of respondents' parental rights was in the best interests of the child. In re Frey, 297 Mich App 242, 248; 824 NW2d 569 (2012). Respondents' challenge to the compliance with the ICWA is without merit in light of the decision on remand. Accordingly, we AFFIRM the trial court's order terminating respondents' parental rights to the minor child. We order that these appeals are now closed.
