The Court orders that the motion to dismiss the appeal as to defendant Gateway Community Health Provider ("Gateway") is DENIED and appellant's motion for leave to file a supplemental brief is GRANTED. However, the proffered supplemental brief is not accepted for filing because it unnecessarily repeats the principal brief with respect to the other defendants and does not comply with the requirements of MCR 7.212(C)(5) and (6) with respect to Gateway. See *People v Price*, 214 Mich App 538, 548; 543 NW2d 49 (1996)(an issue not raised in the statement of questions presented as required by MCR 7.212(C)(5) is not preserved for review). Within 14 days after the Clerk's certification of this order, appellant shall file a supplemental brief that identifies an issue with respect to Gateway in the "Statement of Questions Presented" portion of the brief and includes the information with respect to the granting of summary disposition in favor of Gateway in the "Statement of Facts" portion of the brief as required under MCR 7.212(C)(6). The time for filing Gateway's brief in response under MCR 7.212(A)(2)(a)(ii) shall be calculated from the date of service of the supplemental brief.
